Registering for a Sport

To register for a sport please complete the appropriate Google form. Please note, registration forms are shared via Seesaw and our school newsletter. If there is a certain sport your child is interested in but we do not offer it, please let us know and we can direct you to a local club or look at the possibility of creating a Sherwood team.

Selection of Teams

We generally do not run trials for our teams. Instead teams are selected on the number of players available in a 'first in, first served' basis. If teams are full then we attempt to make multiple teams so that no one misses out. Where possible we will coordinate with other local schools to create hybrid teams so no one misses out. Please note this is not always possible so players are subject to be placed on a waiting list. In the case of picking multiple teams for a certain sport, we try to build teams based on various experience levels to encourage player development.

Sport Classes

Sport classes take place either during school lunchtimes or after school. Classes are run by third party organisations.

- Takes place on Northcross field (next to Sherwood)
- Sessions run on Monday's from 3pm to 3.45pm
- Approximate cost: \$55
- Registrations for this activity are sent out via Seesaw and our school newsletter



School Sports

School sports take place outside of school hours. Games are played once a week at venues outside of Sherwood. Teams generally practice once a week at school either before school, during lunchtime or after school depending on the coaches availability.

Harbour Basketball Primary School Programme

- The East Coast Bays Leisure Centre Programme has now been incorporated into the Harbour Basketball Programme
- This competition is split into two semesters. Semester 1 (Terms 1 & 2) and Semester 2 (Terms 3 & 4)
- Year 1 to 4 (Boys and Girls) and Year 5&6 Girls play on Tuesdays
- Year 5&6 play on Wednesdays
- Teams may play across various venues in the Harbour Region
- For more information regarding game venues, please refer to the registration forms when they become available
- Game times vary each week between 3.30pm - 8pm
- Players are to wear our schools basketball uniform and non-marking shoes
- Players are required to wear a mouthguard
- Cost per semester: \$125

Junior Breakers Basketball

- This competition is split into two semesters. Semester 1 (Terms 1 & 2) and Semester 2 (Terms 3 & 4)
- Teams will need to register for each semester
- Year 3 & 4 Miniball - Friday afternoons/evenings
- Year 5 & 6 Basketball - Tuesday afternoons/evenings
- Games are played at Junior Breakers - 7 Atlas Place, Mairangi Bay
- Game times vary each week between 3.30pm - 8pm
- Players are to wear our schools basketball uniform and non-marking shoes
- Players are also required to wear a mouthguard
- Approximate cost per semester: \$145



Splash Polo

- Available to students in Years 2 to 6
- Leagues run in Terms 1 to 4 (Teams re-register each term).
- Games are played at National Aquatic Centre and AUT Millennium pools
- Practices take place on Saturday and games are played on Sunday
- Newbies Splash Polo (Year 1&2): \$100
- Splash Polo (Year 3 to 6): \$110



Hockey

- Available to students in Years 1 to 6
- Winter league runs during Terms 2 & 3
- Summer league runs during Term 4
- Games are played at North Harbour Hockey on Monday afternoons
- Players wear the school PE uniform and need a hockey stick, shin pads and a mouthguard
- Cost: \$70 (Year 1&2), \$130 (Year 3 & 4), \$140 (Year 5 & 6)



Netball

- Available for students in Years 1 to 6
- Winter league runs in Terms 2 and 3
- Spring league runs in Term 4
- Games are played on Saturdays in the Kidzplay Netball competition run at Pinehurst School
- Winter League: \$105
- Spring League: \$30



Touch Rugby

- Available for students in Years 1 to 6
- League runs in Term 4
- There are two Local Touch Junior Modules – Monday afternoon and Thursday afternoon
- Game venues are subject to change, however, games are generally played at Sunnynook Park
- Cost: \$70



Sports Uniforms

Students who represent the school in a sport are required to wear the school PE uniform. Please note, some sports have a separate uniform that is issued at the start of the season. These include hockey, netball and basketball. For our Northern Bays events, a representative shirt will be loaned out to players.

Northern Bays Festivals and North Harbour Competitions

Sherwood Primary is part of the Northern Bays cluster of schools. Throughout the year, there are various sporting festivals/events our students can take part in with Northern Bays schools and the wider North Harbour region. Please note for some of these events students will need to be selected. These events take place during the school day.

Athletics – Northern Bays

- Available to students in Years 4 to 6 who place in the Top 3 in two or more events at our schools Senior Athletics Day
- Event takes place at Kristin School in Term 4
- Approximate cost: \$20

Badminton – North Harbour Team Challenge

- Available to students in Year 5&6 only
- Event takes place at Harcourts Cooper & Co North Harbour Badminton Centre
- Maximum of two teams of 4-6 players can enter
- Approximate cost: \$10
- In preparation for the competition, teams will host Willow Park School for a badminton exchange



Cricket

- Available for students in Years 3 to 6
- Cricket Zone Day (Boys and Girls) takes place at the end of Term 1
- Komatsu Girls Smash Festival takes place at the start of Term 4
- Event is held at East Coast Bays Cricket Club, Windsor Park



Cross Country – Northern Bays

- Available for students in Years 4 to 6 who place in the Top 6 at our schools Cross Country event
- Takes place at Long Bay Primary School in Term 2
- Approximate cost: \$10

Football/Soccer – Northern Bays

- Available for students in Years 3 to 6
- We have 2 teams available per division: 2x Year 3&4 Boys, 2x Year 3&4 Girls, 2x Year 5&6 Boys and 2x Year 5&6 Girls
- Where possible we try to include everyone who wishes to play, however, in the event of too many registrations we will hold trials to select teams
- Approximate cost: \$12



Gymnastics – North Harbour Competition

- Available for students in Years 1 to 6
- Recreational gymnastics runs during Terms 1 and 2 on Monday lunchtimes in the school gym (No sign up required).
- Competitive gymnastics takes place during Terms 3 and 4 on Monday lunchtimes (students must register for this)
- North Harbour Primary Schools Gymnastics Competition takes place in Term 4
- Gymnasts participate in weekly coaching sessions at school with 2 optional extra sessions at NHG venue in preparation for the competition
- Recreational gymnastics: No cost
- Competitive Gymnastics - Approximate cost: \$35-\$85



Rippa Rugby – North Harbour Festivals

- Available for students in Years 3 to 6
- Festivals takes place in Term 2 and Term 3
- Games are played at East Coast Bays Rugby Club - Windsor Park
- Depending on the students year group, they can play Year 3&4 Rippa or Year 5&6 Rippa
- Approximate cost: \$45



Softball – North Harbour Zone Day

- Available for students in Years 5 and 6
- Takes place in the 2nd week of Term 4
- Held Rosedale Park
- Approximate cost: \$10



Snowplanet Snowsports Championship

- Open to skiers and snowboarders from Years 1 to 6
- Students are required to be able to navigate the slope at Snowplanet by themselves and complete the race course in a safe manner
- This event is not suitable for those new to skiing or snowboarding
- The event consists of 2x slalom runs and an optional rail jam
- Dates to be confirmed, these will be shared via Seesaw and the school newsletter
- Approximate cost: \$69

Swimming – Northern Bays Interschool Competition

- Available for students in Years 4 to 6
- Takes place on Thursday 2nd April
- Held at Sir Owen G. Glenn National Aquatic Centre
- Approximate cost: \$10

Swimming – North Shore Primary Competition

- Depending on the results of the Northern Bays Swimming Competition, students may have the opportunity to compete in this event
- Takes place on Tuesday 5th May
- Held at Sir Owen G. Glenn National Aquatic Centre
- Approximate cost: \$10

Winter Sports Festival – Northern Bays

- Year 6 teams are invited to compete
- Established teams are selected to play, however in some cases it is necessary to run trials to create teams
- Sports include Basketball, Netball, Football and Hockey
- Event is held at Kristin School in Term 3
